David Daokui Li is the Mansfield Freeman Chair Professor of Economics, Director of Center for China in the World Economy (CCWE), and the Director of the Schwarzman Scholars at Tsinghua University. He is now a member of the 12th Chinese People's Political Consultative Committee (CPPCC), and a member of Sino-German Economic Advisory Council. He's also a member of the Global Agenda Council of the World Economic Forum based in Switzerland. Besides, he serves as the Vice Chairman of China Society of World Economics, and editorial member of Economic Research Journal, World Economy and other journals, a Distinguished Research Fellow of China Society of Economic Reform (CSRE) and guest commentator of China Central Television (CCTV). Mr. Li previously served as the member of Monetary Policy Committee of the People's Bank of China, consultant of World Bank, and Chairman of the Chinese Economists Society (CES) (2001-2002).

David Daokui Li graduated from Tsinghua University and obtained a B.S. in 1985. In 1992, he obtained the Ph.D. in Economics from Harvard University, and was under the tutelage of the Nobel Economics Prize winners Eric Maskin, Andrei Shleifer and Janos Kornai. He majored in the comparative economics system, economic theory and corporate banking. Professor Li acted as an economics professor of University of Michigan and Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, and the state researcher of Hoover Institution at Stanford University.


