The SMARTSeas PH Project will host a Partners' Forum with a theme: People and the Sea on October 8 – 12, 2018 in Davao City. The Partners' Forum aims to bring together marine protected area managers from the project sites, partners from the local and national government agencies, civil society organizations, academic and research institutions, and private sector working on protection and conservation of the coastal and marine environment.

The three-day forum will be a venue for partners to exchange experiences, innovative ideas and community-based initiatives to enhance effectiveness of marine protected areas and scaling up to MPA networks, strengthen the science-policy interphase and integration at all scales, increase networking, and foster local and national collaborations.
