






Partnership

LEADING SECTORS

- Dinas for Women Empowerment, Child Protection, and Community and Village Empowerment: child protection, meeting of child rights/needs, gender mainstreaming
 - Dinas for Social Affairs: child protection, support for the aged, people with disabilities, poor people
- Dinas for Education and Culture: sholarship, inclusive education/school
 - Dinas for Health: Health insurance

Other Dinases



"BERSINAR" PROGRAM

- Literally means "shine," "successful,"
- It stands for "berdikari: self-reliant," "sejahtera: prosperous,"indah: beautiful," "aman: safe," and "religius: religious"
- Applied mainly in five sectors: Fisheries, Education, Health, Religious Affairs, and SMEs
 - Complement national programs

"BERSINAR" PROGRAM

- Education: Scholarship and assistance for education cost
- SMEs: providing fund for SMEs with no interest.

Fisheries: insurance for fishermen and capital

Health: insurance, in addition to those from national program

District Government

- Taking efforts to become an accountable and effective public authorities.
- Recently, launching some applications to aim for "egovernment."
- The role of ICT is promising
- Open to dialogues, negotiation, and collaboration with NGOs/CSOs
- Challenges with the climate change, in relation to food and nutrition security
- Commitment to gender equality; recently adding "wowine festival" in its calendar of events (wowine = women)

Environmental Standard

- Collaborating with many organizations to improve livelihood security and well-being of local peoples and communities, contribute to broader sustainable development, and to maintain and enhance biodiversity and ecosystem services.
