2. *Abstract must reflect either an institutionalized, and/or recognized practice in river ecosystem management and/or emerging trend on river basin governance with special emphases on local governance;*
3. Abstract will undergo through a competitive screening process. If officially selected, the organizers will request formally to the city mayor to develop the abstract into full presentation and present it in time for the Summit in Marikina City.
4. Include a separate page for author/s, affiliation/s, and contact addresses.
